

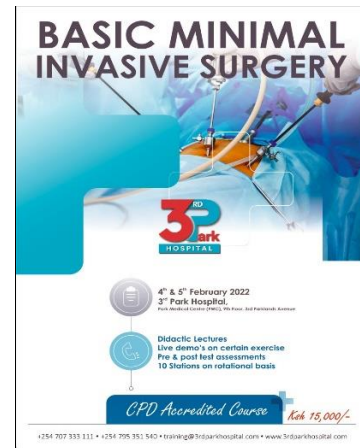


BASIC MINIMAL INVASIVE SURGERY WORKSHOP (BMIS)

Over the last 20-30 years, minimal invasive surgery (MIS) has grown from its niche area to be a mainstream surgical speciality with growing scope of procedures done, ranging from gynaecology, general surgery, and urology to even more complex fields such as transplant, cardiac and orthopaedic surgery.

Surgical training in this era would thus be incomplete without a formal training and guidance in the technique of MIS procedures. This workshop will allow participants to practise and enhance basic skills in minimal invasive surgery (BMIS).

A variety of basic skills stations are planned to allow every participant to pass through various skills necessary for basic laparoscopy work. Trainees will thus be able to demonstrate basic laparoscopic technologies and also have adequate skill to handle laparoscopic instruments and camera.
